Echoes of mercy, whispers of love.

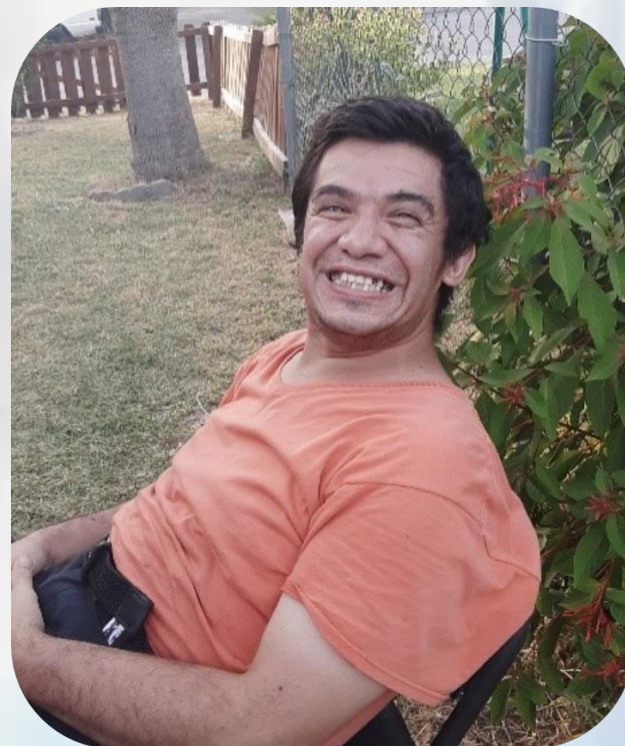
